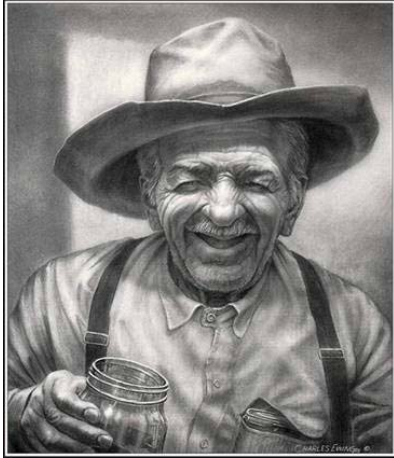
Not so hot summer day at Parkdale Mall
